By 2027, 70% of households pay less than 30% of their income on housing





Goal 1: Give Kids a Strong Start


Target: By 2027, reduce the reading proficiency gap to no more than 10 percentage points between all third-grade students and students from populations with historical inequities.

2020 Baseline: The gap between all students and specific groups ranges from 20-24%



Goal 2: Empower Neighbors to Thrive - Not Just Survive

Target: By 2027, 70% of households pay less than 30% of their income on housing **Baseline**: 65% of households pay less than 30% of their income on housing **2021 Benchmark**: 68% of households pay less than 30% of their income on housing



Goal 3: Help Us All Live Longer, Better

Target: By 2027, reduce preventable premature deaths by 10%. **Baseline**: 6128 Years of Potential Life Lost per 100,000 people
